

# Basic Fire Awareness and Fire Warden or Fire Marshall Training

**Course Duration:** Short Duration Course

**Aim and Objectives:**

Employees are trained how to react in the event that they discover a fire. The training involves a theory and practical session in which all candidates are given the opportunity to extinguish a real fire which is generated safely by our fire simulator. Several staff are usually trained to be Fire Wardens for the purpose of:

- Testing fire alarms on a regular basis
- Visual checking of portable fire equipment
- Preventing means of escape becoming littered and blocked
- Trained to quickly evacuate staff and roll call
- Liaising with the fire brigade
