

IPAF Site Assessment (for MEWP Selection Training Course)

Course Duration: 1/2 Day

Selecting a Mobile Elevating Work Platform (MEWP) can be complex and challenging. Being confident and sufficiently knowledgeable to select the correct MEWP for the job directly reduces the risk. Correct MEWPS selection also improves effectiveness and efficiency of MEWP operation, reducing unnecessary costs and creating the ability to work to slicker timescales.

Who is the course for:

The course is for anyone that will be choosing which MEWP to use for a task:

- Those working for rental companies who need to determine which type of MEWP a client should rent/hire from them for the work required
- Those working in any industry, such as Managers/Supervisors, who wish to gain the confidence and knowledge required to make their own decision about which kind of MEWP to rent/hire for the work required
- Health and Safety professionals will also benefit from this course as when auditing works, they will be better able to determine whether the equipment being used is correct or whether there would be a better and safer option

Aim and Objectives:

The course will guide candidates through the process of determining the optimum MEWP for a given task:

Course Content:

- Introduction and housekeeping
- Height
- Reach
- Up-and-over height
- Weight of people
- Required materials and tools
- Environment
- Restrictions

- Set-up
- Hazards
- Permits
- Accessories
- Deliveries
- Completion of documentation to justify the selection

Pre-Requisites for Candidates:

All candidates must hold a valid PAL Card for operator training or a MEWPS for Managers qualification.

Literacy and language comprehension are important requirements on all courses.

Training Location Options:

We offer this course from both our Devon and Cornwall training centres as well as giving customers the option to hold training on site at a location of their choice (subject to the proposed venue having a suitable classroom facility and any other necessary facilities required for this course). Please note that whilst this course is predominantly classroom based, when training at either of our training centres we like to incorporate a practical session where candidates carry out a risk assessment and machine selection exercise on real MEWPs. Therefore it is preferable, but not essential for MEWPs to be available at potential on-site training locations.

Course Start Time:

All courses unless agreed otherwise will commence at 8.00am.

Certification:

Candidates must correctly answer at least 80% (24 out of 30) of the 30 questions asked in the multiplechoice theory test paper. Candidates who do not meet this criterial will need to attend the full course again.

There is no expiration date on the certificate.

IMPORTANT - Please note: All candidates who undertake IPAF training and pass will get their license and/or certification through IPAF's new app, **ePAL**. In addition, the Co-ordinator of the booking will receive a digital copy once payment has been received in full.

The app is available on iOS and Android apps (search ePAL) and we request that delegates download this app to their smart phone ahead of the course.

*Candidates receive only a certificate (digital from 01/06/2021) and not a PAL card/licence on completion of this course.

Equipment:

Candidates attending training at either of our training centres are asked to wear safety footwear and Hi-Viz jacket or vest. Writing materials will be provided.

Lunch and Refreshment Facilities:

Lunches will not be provided. Water, tea, coffee, fridge and microwave facilities are available in our canteen for use your use free of charge.

Accommodation and Transport:
