

UKATA Asbestos Awareness

Course Duration: 0.5 Day

Who will benefit from this course:

This is a mandatory training requirement under Regulation 10 of the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 for all those who are exposed or liable to be exposed to Asbestos containing material. This would include but not limited to Carpenters, Plumbers, Engineers, Maintenance Workers, Cable Installers, Shop Fitters, Demolition, Operatives, Construction Workers, Architects and Surveyors.

Aims and Objectives:

Candidates who complete this training will:

- Gain a clearer understanding of the potential ill health effect of exposure to asbestos;
- Be better able to identify areas where asbestos could be found
- Understand the action to take upon discovery;
- Have a greater awareness of the main types of asbestos likely to be found within their workplace;
- Have a greater awareness of many of the products within which asbestos was originally included.

Course Content:

The candidate attending the course will receive a globally recognised and respected certificated training course with peace of mind from the training that has been designed and quality-assured by the awarding body UKATA. This will be achieved through the following course modules:

- History of Asbestos
- Types of Asbestos
- Potential health effects
- Overview of Relevant Legislation
- Locations/Identification of possible Asbestos Containing Materials (ACMs)
- Working Operations
- Asbestos Surveys and Procedures Upon Discovery
