

Basic HAKI System Training (SSPTS)

Course Duration: 2 Day

It is now a requirement for CISRS Training Centres to apply for CISRS cards upon completion of short duration courses - see Certification/Card Application details below.

Aim and Objectives:

This two day SSPTS (Systems Scaffold Product Training Scheme) course will give attendees the theoretical knowledge and the practical skills to safely and effectively erect, alter and dismantle basic Haki universal system scaffolding. Please note that this course is not intended for non-scaffolders (see pre-requisites for candidates below for further details).

At the end of the course candidates should be able to:

- Identify and select Haki components
- Interpret and apply relevant current regulations and codes of practice
- Erect, alter and dismantle in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions

Course Content:

- Introduction and welcome
- Course scope, aims and objectives
- Health and safety
- Introduction to Haki and their basic systems of work
- Haki scaffold tower
- Haki universal tied independent
- Haki stair tower
- Haki basic component range and basic erection procedures including AGR demonstration
- HAKI loading tower
- HAKI birdcage
- Question paper

The successful achievement of the above training objectives will be demonstrated using the following assessment methods:

- Theory test to assess trainees comprehension of course
- Practical ability assessments

Pre-Requisites for Candidates:

Candidates wishing to attend the Haki system training must hold a current CISRS card having completed a minimum of the Part 1 training through either the tube and fitting or system scaffolding route. Candidates must be able to provide us with a copy of their training certificate or endorsed CISRS trainee/scaffolder card which we need to keep on file.

Literacy and language comprehension are important requirements on all courses.

Any physical impairment or literacy issues should be discussed with LTC Training Services Ltd prior to making a booking so we can best accommodate your needs.

Training Location Options:

Due to the nature of this training course i.e. that it involves the physical erection of live scaffold structures this course can be held only in our Scaffold Training School based on the site of our head office in Plymouth, Devon.

Course Start Time:

All courses unless agreed otherwise will commence at 8.15am.

Certification/CISRS Card Endorsement Application:

Certificates are included in the cost of this course and are produced by LTC Training Services Ltd. They will be forwarded to the customer once payment has been received in full.

PLEASE NOTE: As detailed above the application for the CISRS Card Endorsement must now be made by the training provider.

Please note that it will be the responsibility of the candidate and not LTC Training Services Ltd to book and pay for any Health, Safety & Environment test if required.

Equipment:

You will be required to wear PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) during the practical aspects of your course. LTC Training Services Ltd will provide you with a harness and lanyard for your use during training. You will be required to bring with you your own hard hat, safety boots, high visibility vest and tools (1 x scaffold spanner, 1 x 22mm spanner, 1 x belt and frog, 1 x spirit level, 1 x tape measure and a podger/ hammer).

Lunch and Refreshment Facilities:

Lunches will not be provided. However water, tea, coffee, fridge and microwave facilities are available in our canteen for your use free of charge.

Accommodation and Transport:

Candidates are required to organise and pay for their own accommodation and transport should it be required. A list of local accommodation can be provided on request.

Number of Candidates per Course:

A maximum of 9

Refresher Training:

SSPTS Training has no expiry date. Candidates must however renew their CISRS Scaffolder card with Haki Endorsement every 5 years.
