

IPAF Demonstrator



Course Duration: 1 Day

Aim and Objectives:

The IPAF demonstrator course is for anyone who needs to familiarise operators to use MEWPs (Mobile Elevating Working Platforms), which differs significantly to the training they have received.

As well as meeting the requirements for IPAF operators, demonstrators are required to familiarise operators with their responsibilities and demonstrate pre-operational and safe operating procedures and the limitations of MEWPs.

Course Content:

- Introduction and pre-theory test
- MEWP Categories
- PPE & Harness statement
- Operator revision and responsibilities and responsibilities for familiarisation
- Effective demonstration
- Practical demonstration
- Handovers
- Demonstrator theory test

Machine Categories:

The IPAF machine categories are as follows:

- 1A – Static Vertical (e.g. personnel lift)
- 3A – Mobile Vertical (e.g. mobile scissor lift)
- 1B – Static Boom (e.g. van/lorry mounted boom)
- 3B – Mobile Boom (e.g. mobile boom lift)

Pre-Requisites for Candidates:

Candidates must hold a valid IPAF operator license in the categories of machine they wish to demonstrate.

Literacy and language comprehension are important requirements on all courses.

Any physical impairment or literacy issues should be discussed with LTC Training Services Ltd prior to making a booking so we can best accommodate your needs.

Training Location Options:

We offer this course from both our Devon and Cornwall training centres as well as giving customers the option to hold training on site at a location of their choice (subject to the proposed venue having a suitable classroom facility and any other necessary facilities and equipment required for this course). Course Start Time:

All courses unless agreed otherwise will commence at 8.00am.

Certification:

IMPORTANT - Please note: All candidates who undertake IPAF training and pass will get their license and/or certification through IPAF's new app, **ePAL**. In addition, the Co-ordinator of the booking will receive a digital copy once payment has been received in full.

The app is available on iOS and Android apps (search ePAL) and we request that delegates download this app to their smart phone ahead of the course.

The training is valid for 5 years.

Equipment:

Candidates are required to wear appropriate PPE (safety footwear, hard hat, gloves, safety harness and hi-viz jacket or vest). Candidates should also bring wet weather clothing in case of inclement weather. Writing materials will be provided. Candidates who do not have any of these items should make us aware of this at the time of booking.

Lunch and Refreshment Facilities:

A lunch (e.g. baguette/sandwich and crisps) is included at no extra cost. Water, tea, coffee, fridge and microwave facilities are also available in our canteen for your use free of charge.

Unfortunately we are not able to provide lunches when training is carried out on-site.

Accommodation and Transport:

Candidates are required to organise and pay for their own accommodation and transport should it be required. A list of local accommodation can be provided on request.

Number of Candidates per Course:

Maximum of 4 (to demonstrate 2 categories of machine)

Maximum of 6 (to demonstrate 1 category of machine)
